HDSLGC Statement of Compliance – GDPR

Your choices

You have a choice about whether to receive information from us. If you do not want to receive email communications from us concerning HDSLGC events, you should advise your local Club Representative &/or the Secretary of HDSLGC.

You have the right to withdraw consent at any time; if you choose to do so you should contact your Club Representative &/or the Secretary of HDSLGC.

How can you access and update your information?

You have the right to access your information by contacting your Club Representative &/or the HDSLGC Secretary. The accuracy of your information is important to us. We make every effort to ensure that contact details are updated as advised & we would encourage you to let us know as soon as possible if your details change.

Security precautions in place to protect the loss, misuse or alteration of your information

When you give us personal information, we take steps to ensure that it's treated securely. Our volunteer committee officials work from personal computers, using the Internet, and this can never be guaranteed to be 100% secure. However, we encourage everyone to maintain up to date antivirus software & take every normal precaution to prevent unauthorised access to your information. As a result, while we strive to protect your personal information, we cannot guarantee

the security of any information that you transmit to us, and you do so at your own risk. Once we receive your information, we make our best effort to ensure its security.
